



## **PETS**

The animal control was provided by an animal control officer employed by the Town up until the service needed to be suspended indefinitely. For several years, the Town of Temiscaming transferred unclaimed stray dogs and cats to the Humane Society in North Bay for adoption. Because of the high number of stray animals brought to the shelter, they are no longer able to accommodate animals from outside of North Bay. The SPCA in Rouyn-Noranda cannot assist us for the same reasons.

The animal control service remains suspended while the situation is being analysed in order to evaluate the type of service the Town will offer in the future. Therefore, animal owners must deal with a veterinary if they wish to give up their pets.

However, regulations regarding animals will still be in effect: animal owners (dogs and cats) must always keep their animal tied on their property and must also ensure that they do not disturb the peace of their neighbours.
