- 4) Ballots can not be bought.
- 5) Ballots must be deposited in an official ballot box in participating businesses.
- 6) Two prizes will be drawn: The first winner will receive 10 individual \$100.00 certificates totalling \$1000.00. The second winner will receive 5 individual \$100.00 certificates totalling \$500.00. The winners can exchange one certificate per participating businesses. The winners will have 4 hours to spend their certificates.
- 7) The winning ballot will be drawn during the Lions Telethon 2008 edition. The winners will also announced on channel 13.
- 8) The winning ballot must have the official seal of the Chamber of Commerce to be accepted as a valid ballot.
- 9) The employees and the members of the CCTK executive council as well as any other person living at the same address are not eligible to participate in the contest.
- 10) The winners have until December 31st 2008 to spend their vouchers accompanied by the Channel 13 crew. The footage will be broadcast on CCTV-13 the following month.
- 11) Any litigation respecting the conduct or organization of a publicity contest may be submitted to the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux for a ruling.
