NOTICE ON RESIDENTIAL POOL SAFETY

- · Pools installed on or after July 22, 2010: The September 30, 2025 compliance deadline will be postponed by at least one year by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs.
- Pools installed before July 22, 2010: You currently remain exempt.

TEMPORARY CAR SHELTERS

The prohibition period for temporary car shelters—from May 1 to November 1—is coming to an end for this year.

If you plan to install a temporary car shelter on your property, please note:

- The required front setback is 1 metre.
- Side setbacks are the same as for detached accessory buildings and vary by municipal zone.
- No building permit is required.

The Town is currently selling residential lots in the Letang sector.

3RD TAX INSTALLMENT - DUE OCTOBER 31ST

Haven't made your payment yet? Here's how to pay your municipal tax bill:

IN PERSON

- At Town Hall
- Accepted payments: cash, money order, or cheque

ONLINE BANKING

- · Log in to your online banking account
- Go to the bill payments section
- Add the payee : City of Temiscaming Taxes (QC) : Enter your 16-digit reference number (your roll number or identification code beginning with "F" — enter only the 16 digits, no F, period, or dash)

Do you own multiple properties in Temiscaming? Repeat these steps for each property and make sure each payment is applied to the correct account to avoid interest or penalties.
