MAYOR'S MESSAGE

At the Town of Temiscaming, we choose to invest in what brings people together and contributes to their quality of life. A significant portion of the municipal budget is dedicated to sports, recreation, culture and community life because these services play an essential role for our youth, families, seniors and, more broadly, in the vitality of our community.

At a time when the costs of maintaining and operating our infrastructure continue to rise, we believe it is important to maximize their use and work in partnership with the organizations that bring them to life. Several recent positive developments show just how effective this approach can be.

THE RETURN OF THE TITANS

Like many of you, I have been following the return of the Titans with great interest. The work accomplished over the past few months by the new owners, with the remarkable involvement of Denis Lacourse and many volunteers, deserves recognition.

There is already a great deal of excitement in the community. The players are ready, the coaching staff is ready, the ice will soon be ready and, starting August 24, a new chapter will begin for the organization.

The Town is pleased to have entered into a new partnership and facility-use agreement with the Titans. We wish them an excellent season and hope to see our community come out in large numbers to support them.

MINOR HOCKEY ON THE RISE

Minor hockey also holds a very important place in our community. We are proud that Temiscaming is recognized as a true hockey town and we want to continue providing a positive environment for our youth.

Last winter, participation grew significantly, to the point where additional teams and ice time had to be added. This year, a new partnership agreement has been reached with the organization to provide even more benefits for young families.

Beyond the sport itself, hockey contributes to the vitality of our community. Tournaments, activities and events attract visitors, increase local activity and generate positive economic benefits for several sectors of our local economy.

THE RETURN OF THE MOOSE PARTY

Over the past few months, the TEAMPanache committee, which organizes the Moose Party, has met with the Town to discuss the future of the event and the challenges involved in organizing it.

We listened to their needs and worked together to find a solution that would help bring the event back. The Moose Party is much more than a festive gathering. It attracts visitors, generates significant economic benefits for our community, and helps support various local projects and organizations.

That is why we are very pleased to announce that a partnership agreement has been reached with the TEAMPanache committee. Thanks to this collaboration, the Moose Party will return and continue to contribute to the vitality and visibility of Temiscaming.

NEW MOMENTUM FOR THE GOLF CLUB

Several residents had expressed their desire to see the golf club continue to develop. As we already do with curling, minor hockey and other activities, we encouraged the creation of a committee bringing users together to work collaboratively on the priorities moving forward.

This approach creates a direct dialogue with those who use the facilities and helps us better target our investments.

Yes, some sports fees have been adjusted in recent years, particularly for non-residents. However, these adjustments also come with a clear commitment from the Town to improve its facilities and services.

At the golf club, this includes painting the clubhouse, adding new furniture to the patios, renewing signage throughout the course, improving landscaping and purchasing new golf carts.

We want to provide quality facilities while also strengthening the pride we share in our community and in the infrastructure that belongs to all of us.

THE HEALTHCARE CORRIDOR WITH ONTARIO

I would also like to provide an update on the healthcare corridor with Ontario.

As I mentioned recently, we have never been closer to reaching an agreement. A small working committee consisting of a representative from the Premier’s Office, the Deputy Minister of Health, the Prefect and myself continues to work on finalizing the last steps of the process.

Discussions between Quebec representatives and the North Bay Regional Health Centre are ongoing, and a first draft agreement has already been prepared. A meeting is scheduled for the end of August to continue discussions.

We remain cautious, as an agreement is never final until it is signed. However, the signs are positive and we are seeing a genuine willingness to collaborate on both sides.

WORKING TOGETHER FOR THE FUTURE

All of these developments have one thing in common: they are the result of collaboration.

The Town can maintain infrastructure, support projects and provide services, but it is our volunteers, organizations, users, municipal employees and residents who bring them to life every day.

When everyone contributes in their own way and we work toward the same goals, we build a stronger, more dynamic community that we can all be proud of.

Together, we are moving Temiscaming forward. Thank you to everyone who plays a part in making it happen.

BUSINESSES, INDUSTRIES AND INSTITUTIONS: CHECK YOUR METERS!

The water meter initiative is continuing in Temiscaming.

This initiative is part of Quebec’s Drinking Water Conservation Strategy and supports the Town’s obligations related to monitoring water consumption.

Over the next few weeks, businesses, industries and institutions in Temiscaming will receive a form to submit their water meter reading.

Why are we doing this? The Town needs a better understanding of water consumption in non-residential buildings. This information will provide a more accurate picture of water use, help identify unusual consumption and support better planning for our water system.

At this stage, meter readings will be used to collect the data and statistics needed on water consumption. No billing is associated with this data collection at this time.

It only takes a few minutes. Your cooperation helps us collect more accurate data and better manage our drinking water system.

A MUNICIPAL ISSUE TO REPORT?

A pothole? A broken streetlight? A water leak? Damaged equipment in a park?

The Town of Temiscaming’s request system allows you to report an issue that requires the attention of a municipal department.

Your request is recorded and directed to the appropriate department to help ensure proper processing and follow-up.
