



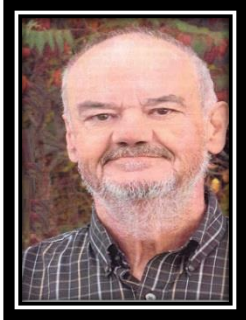

Due to the major investments of the last few years, it is important to note that 23% of our 2018 Budget is dedicated to debt re-imbursement and financing costs.

The Town Council members work towards improving the quality of life for our citizens, without having to raise taxes in a significant manner.

The main projects for 2018 are the following:

- Redesign of the Town entrance-Letang area
- Finalize the pipeline interpretation circuit project
- Finalize the move of the Fire Station

- Selective collection (residence) - \$151,36

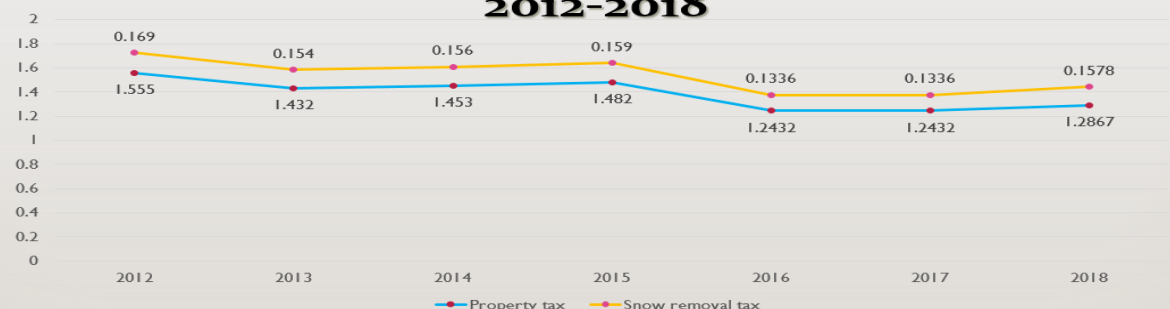

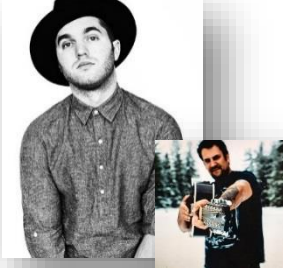
