Several sites for residents of the Unorganized Territories (TNO), Thompson's Bay Road and Gordon Lake, are being littered with garbage and large items by visitors and citizens of the Town. These illegal acts cause major problems for the users and the public works department. Not only are the bins full, but the vast majority of this waste is found next to the bins which attracts bears and crows. Cameras were installed to apprehend the culprits and some fines were issued. But the problem persists!

# PARCOURS? POÉTIQUE Témiscaming


As part of the CulturAT initiative, the school, the Town, the Chamber of Commerce and the Richelieu Club join forces to give life to a unique poetry project.
