Featured Topic: Candles



There are many types of decorative candles and candlesticks available today which create a pleasant atmosphere in your home.

When purchasing a candlestick, make sure that it is safe to use. It should be stable, big and deep enough to hold all the wax. Candlesticks made of tempered glass withstand heat while those of regular glass, wood or even plastic are more dangerous.

Any candlestick may be used with the condition that you never leave a lighted candle unattended. Many fires are caused by candles which people forgot to watch: The candle burns down completely, causing the candlestick to burn or shatter if it is made of a non-heat resistant material. You should extinguish any candle when it is 5 cm (2 in.) from the candlestick.

Never light candles near curtains or any other flammable object.
