Reference document concerning residual waste management

This reference document was written to help citizens improve the way they sort various materials generated from their homes.

In addition to the door-to-door selective waste collection for recyclable, compostable materials and garbage, some materials should be deposited elsewhere.

Hence, this document is a tool to help you get rid of materials than cannot or should not be deposited in bins for the door-to-door selective waste collection, but rather, sent to the regional EcoCentre in Fabre or one of the Local Relay EcoCentres located on the territory.







1) ULTIMATE WASTE (non-reclaimable)

Materials that cannot be salvaged, reused or recycled






3) METAL

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ♦ Metal electrical appliances (toaster, iron, kettle, coffee maker, etc.) ♦ Bicycles ♦ Air conditioner, furnace, hot water tank ♦ Appliances (stove, refrigerator, microwave, washer, etc.) ♦ Electrical wires (Christmas lights, extension cords, etc.) ♦ Ferrous and non-ferrous metals ♦ Materials containing more than 75% of metal 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Bring these materials to the regional EcoCentre in Fabre or your Local Relay EcoCentre. <div style="text-align: center; margin-top: 20px;"> <div style="border: 1px solid black; background-color: #008000; color: white; padding: 5px; display: inline-block;">EcoCentre or Local Relay EcoCentre (LRE)</div> </div>

5) ELECTRONIC & ELECTRIC APPLIANCES and COMPUTER EQUIPMENT



7) HAZARDOUS DOMESTIC WASTE

<p>Used oils :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Oils (mineral, vegetable or synthetic) ◆ Used oil filters ◆ Oil containers 	
<p>Organic hazardous domestic waste :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Acetone, adhesive, rubbing alcohol, antifreeze, caulking compound, wax, glue, dye, fuel, degreasing agent, epoxy, diluent, ink, gasoline, heating gas-oil, lubricant, methanol, oven cleaner, shoe dye, turpentine, etc. 	
<p>Inorganic hazardous domestic waste :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Acids, bases, pesticides, oxidants 	
<p>Compact lamps and fluorescent lamps :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Compact fluorescent lamps ◆ Fluorescent lamps ◆ High intensity discharge lamps ◆ Low pressure sodium lamps ◆ UV lamps ◆ LED lamps ◆ Etc. 	
<p>Rechargeables and non-rechargeable batteries :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Alkaline ◆ Nickel-cadmium















8) GREEN RESIDUE

Examples	Recommended / Required method of disposal
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ♦ Grass cuttings ♦ Falling leaves ♦ Garden residue ♦ Wood residue (sawdust, chips) 	<p>If there is too much green residue to fit into your green bin, bring the residue to the EcoCentre in Fabre. (The residue will be composted on the composting deck)</p>

9) REUSABLE OBJECTS AND ITEMS (in good condition)

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ♦ Clothing ♦ Baby items ♦ Sports equipment ♦ Furniture ♦ Etc. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All items in good condition and reusable should be brought directly to your nearest family help centre.

10) RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ♦ Paper and cardboard ♦ Plastic and plastic bags ♦ Tin cans, beverage cans and aluminum plates ♦ Glass bottles and jars 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Place recyclable materials in your blue bin - Bring any surplus to the EcoCentre in Fabre or ask if your local relay EcoCentre will accept them.
