The Town of Temiscaming has hired Lamothe Sintra to pave three sites in early October.

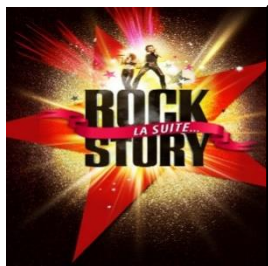
- Section of Kipawa Road – Station Centre-Ville to the Rest area
